- 1989 Start of Youth for Europe
- 2000 Start of SALTO-YOUTH Inclusion
- 2002 First Inclusion strategy for YOUTH
(2007 Youth in Action, 2014 Erasmus+ youth)
- 2021 First cross-sector I&D Strategy for the whole Erasmus+ and Solidarity Corps



What is the biggest obstacle for Inclusion & Diversity in the EU youth programmes?

We asked national agencies & organisations

1. People don't believe it concerns them
2. But we are open, they just don't come
3. The administration is too big/unfriendly
4. Difficult to have a wider/lasting impact
5. I&D should be default, not a special action
